**Proud to be a Rotarian**

I really enjoyed the Article in the August Rotarian "Reasons to Love Rotary Right Now". There were ten listed reasons, and I certainly agree with number one being number one – that being Polio eradication. By the way, they also have an article on the progress in Pakistan in the October Rotarian.

I also liked number two – being associated with Rotarians around the world who are people of action.

I also enjoyed the article about the Romanian/German Rotarian who won the Nobel Prize in Chemistry in 2014. The story is that the microscope was limited in its abilities by the wavelength of light shining into it. And since wavelength of light is fixed and can't be altered, then the microscope's abilities is limited – stated in 1873 by German physicist Ernest Abbe and universally accepted by scientists since that time. (AKA "The Diffraction Barrier")

The Rotarian Nobel Laureate was named Stefan Hell of the Rotary Club of Gottingen, Germany. He grew up under communist rule in Romania and knew that there was a chasm between what officials told him to believe and what was true. So, in spite of "...an entire scientific community saying advance in this area was impossible, Hell pursued a career dedicated to breaking past the long believed barrier with hopes of creating a light microscope capable of illuminating a world that humans had never seen." Eventually, Hell and his colleagues "found that by switching the ability of molecules to fluoresce on and off to make them discernible, the diffraction barrier could be broken."

Reminded me of Alfred Einstein. For many years, scientists believed that light traveled by waves, just as sound does, therefore, it had to have a medium to travel through. This postulated medium in space was called "ether" or "aether". They even inserted a "factor" into their formulas to account for it. Problem was whatever value they gave it, it just didn't seem to work out right. Einstein thought, what if it ain't so. Voila, the theory of relativity was born after the factor for ether was removed.

Now, this is greatly oversimplified, so don't ask me to explain any of it. I might do a better job of explaining the Einstein part as I had to do a report on that for Nuclear Physics at Texas Tech – made an A on it (but didn't do near that for the overall course). But that was over 50 years ago!!

Maybe we'd do well to be naïve like Hell was. He said, "Many people told me that it would not work. Sometimes being naïve and a bit ignorant about the difficulties of a subject helps to see it from a radically different angle."

Anyway, we belong to a club with many distinguished folks in it!!
