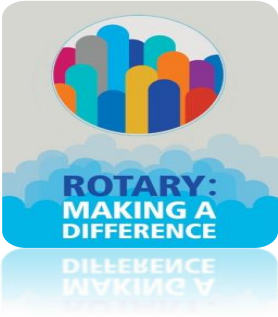


ROOSEVELT COUNTY WEEK!

In the coming weeks, I’d like you to learn a little more about each of these “Focus Areas”, so that YOU can be telling others about Rotary! 1. PROMOTING PEACE! Conflict and violence displace millions of people each year. Half of those killed in conflict are children, and 90 percent are civilians. We refuse to accept conflict as a way of life. Rotary projects provide training that fosters understanding and provides communities with the skills to resolve conflicts.

Rotary makes amazing things happen, like:

Improving quality of life. Rotary members founded the People for People Foundation, which has helped 10,000 families afford food, clothing, rent, utilities, medications, and other necessities.

Raising awareness of bullying. Rotaract clubs in the Philippines conduct anti-bullying campaigns in schools to teach children how to handle conflict peacefully from an early age.

Protecting domestic violence survivors and their families. The U.S. state of Louisiana has the fourth highest incidence of death caused by domestic violence. Local Rotary members met this issue by helping a shelter provide food, clothing, legal advocacy, and counseling to over 500 women in one year.

In light of recent events in Charlottesville, we need to be even MORE involved in peace making and peace SEEKING! Please pray that our Portales club can be a light of peace to our County...and our world!


