PREPARING FOR MARCH

The word 'March' comes from the Roman 'Martius'. This was originally the first month of the Roman calendar and was named after Mars, the god of war who was also regarded as a guardian of agriculture and an ancestor of the Roman people through his sons Romulus and Remus. His month Martius was the beginning of the

season for both farming and warfare, and the festivals held in his honor during the month were mirrored by others in October, when the season for these activities came to a close.

March was the beginning of our calendar year. We changed to the 'New Style' or 'Gregorian calendar in 1752, and it is only since then when we the year began on 1st January.

March 7, 1933 The board game Monopoly was created and trademarked by Charles Darrow in Atlantic City.

March 12, 1894 - Coca-Cola bottles were sold to the public for the first time, in Vicksburg, Mississippi.

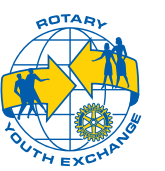
