Fellow Rotarians, recently I had the opportunity to visit the Albuquerque Zoo & BioPark with my kids, and I would HIGHLY recommend this day trip, if you haven't done it! The Aquarium is top notch, the Zoo is clean and animals well cared for, and the new attraction-"The Bug-ariam"-was fantastic! (Even if it creeped me out...yes, it's all about bugs of all types!)

But I was surprised at the Botanical Gardens when I came upon this sign, that the Rotary Club of ABQ sponsored the Children's Fantasy Garden!! What a blessing and a joy! If you've

While I was there, I investigated the Rotary Club's input a little more with some of the Park leadership. It made me think of some of the community things WE have done here in Portales. We have our name on "Rotary Park", and over the years, we have painted benches, added bathrooms, pavilion, grills, walking paths and playgrounds.
